

Parent Commitment

Rock County Christian School has been established on the Biblical principle that God has given parents the primary responsibility for educating their children. The school enters into a partnership with parents as Christian professionals and educators to teach students academics and values.

The Bible is a guide for positive living. It is the role of the school to support and compliment the Biblical principles taught at home. Its principles for living will be taught to your students during daily Bible class and throughout the day. Such character qualities as respect, reverence, obedience, integrity, and responsibility will be emphasized. Included in the Bible's instructions are the precepts that intoxication, pre-marital sex, homosexuality and abortion are contrary to the will of God, and are sins.

Our Mission Statement and Statement of Faith are as follows:

Mission Statement

Rock County Christian School exists to glorify God, to equip students to thrive spiritually, academically, socially and physically and to support Christian parents and churches in the Biblical training of our children.

Statement of Faith

1. We believe the Bible is the only inspired, infallible, and authoritative Word of God in the original text. It is the only rule of faith and practice for our lives.
2. We believe in the one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
3. We believe in the deity of Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory.
4. We believe that fallen man is in need of a complete regeneration by the Holy Spirit which is obtained only by grace through faith in Christ without any work or merit of his own.
5. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life.
6. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost: the saved unto the resurrection of life and the lost unto the resurrection of damnation.
7. We believe in the spiritual unity of those who trust in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.

In addition, I agree to the following:

1. I agree to support the pursuit of academic excellence and the development of Christ-like character at Rock County Christian School.
2. I agree to uphold the Mission Statement and the Statement of Faith, which is stated on the front of this sheet.
3. I will faithfully support the school through my prayers and positive attitude, and should complaints or problems arise, I agree to work them out with the teacher or administrator. I agree to be "part of the solution" not "part of the problem."
4. I adhere to a school standard of conduct which honors God, and grants authority to the teacher or administrator to discipline my child(ren) when necessary, and will support this in my home.
5. I understand that attendance at Rock County Christian School is a privilege that may be withdrawn upon sufficient cause as determined by the administration.
6. I agree to report any prescribed program of medication to the administration.
7. I agree to report any prior or current involvement with the law to the administration.
8. I understand that if my child is experimenting in the use of tobacco, illegal drugs, alcohol, or immortality, they may be expelled from school. I understand that decisions by the administration and/or the school board about this are final and binding.
9. I agree to read and follow the guidelines outlined in the student handbook.
10. I agree to support the school by timely payment of all fees as set forth in the Financial Agreement.
11. I understand that it is my responsibility to inform Rock County Christian School of any changes in my address or telephone number as soon as possible.
